

## Is the Constitution biblical?

(Just the more basic thoughts to ponder, there's MUCH more on this...)

### **Does the U.S. Constitution honor the God of the Bible? ...or does it cleverly establish a new national "government god"?**

#### **United States Constitution**

WE THE PEOPLE of the United States, in order to form a more perfect union, establish justice, ensure domestic tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America. (Preamble, U.S. Constitution) (*Who is being exalted here? YHWH? ..or "government god" fashioned by "we the people" like a golden calf?*)

#### **YHWH's Law**

Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image.... Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I YHWH thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; and shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. (Exodus 20:3-6)

...[YHWH's] law is ignored and justice is never upheld. For the wicked surround the righteous; Therefore, justice comes out perverted. ... Their justice and authority originate with themselves. ... They whose strength is their god. (Habakkuk 1:4-11, NASB)

*Side note: For lo, I raise up the Chaldeans (and their spiritual military machine of Jesuits, illuminati, and their support system of satellite satanic societies), that bitter & furious nation, which shall goe upon the breadth of the lande to possess the dwelling places, that are not theirs. (Habakkuk 1:6 Geneva Bible; insert mine)*

### **Is the U.S. Constitution a Biblical covenant? ...or is it a contract that glorifies humanism?**

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...And they shall scoff at the kings, and the princes shall be a scorn unto them: they shall deride every strong hold; for they shall heap dust, and take it. Then shall *his* mind change, and he shall pass over, and offend, *imputing* this his power unto his god (*or, as IF it is his god—dwaine*). (Habakkuk 1:10,11 KJV)

**Matthew Henry on Habakkuk 1:11 (written about 400 years ago):** Do they depend upon their garrisons and fortified towns? *He shall deride every stronghold,*

for to him it shall be weak, and *he shall heap dust, and take it*; a little soil, thrown up for ramparts, shall serve to give him all the advantage against them that he can desire; he shall make but a jest of them, and a sport of taking them. (5.) By all this he shall be puffed up with an intolerable pride, which shall be his destruction ([Hab 1:11](#)): *Then shall his mind change* for the worse. The spirit both of the people and of the king shall grow more haughty and insolent. Those that will not be content with their own rights will not be content when they have made themselves masters of other people's rights too; but as the condition rises the mind rises too. This victorious king shall *pass over* all the bounds of reason, equity, and modesty, and break through all their bonds, and thereby *he shall offend*, shall make God his enemy, and so prepare ruin for himself by *imputing this his power to his god*, whereas he had it from the God of Israel. *Bel* and *Nebo* were the gods of the Chaldeans, and to them they gave the glory of their successes; they were hardened in their idolatry, and blasphemously argued that because they had conquered Israel their gods were too strong for the God of Israel. Note, It is a great offence (and the common offence of proud people) to take that glory to ourselves, or to give it to gods of our own making, which is due to the living and true God only. These closing words of the sentence give a glimpse of comfort to the afflicted people of God; it is to be hoped that they will change their minds, and grow better, and ripen for deliverance; and they did so. However, their enemies will change their minds, and grow worse, and ripen for destruction, which will inevitably come in God's due time; for a haughty spirit, lifted up against God, *goes before a fall*.

## **Does the U.S. Constitution preserve YHWH's exclusive legislative powers? ...or does it act in usurpation of those powers?**

### **United States Constitution**

All legislative powers herein granted shall be vested in a congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives. (Article 1, Section 1, U.S. Constitution)

### **YHWH's Law**

There is one lawgiver.... (James 4:12)

For YHWH is our ... lawgiver.... (Isaiah 33:22)

The law of YHWH is perfect.... (Psalm 19:7)

## **Does the U.S. Constitution recognize YHWH's executive authority? ...or is it oblivious to that authority?**

### **United States Constitution**

The executive power shall be vested in a President of the United States of America.... (Article 2, Section 1, U.S. Constitution)

### **YHWH's Law**

For YHWH is our ... king.... (Isaiah 33:22)

And YHWH said unto Samuel, ... they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them. (1 Samuel 8:7)

...ye said unto me, Nay; but a king shall reign over us: when YHWH your God was your king. ... your wickedness is great, which ye have done in the sight of YHWH, in asking you a king. (1 Samuel 12:12-17)

But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay *them* before me. (Luk 19:27)

## **Is the U.S. Constitution written to support YHWH's laws? Or is it claiming to be superior to them?**

### **United States Constitution**

This Constitution, and the laws of the United States which shall be made in pursuance thereof; and all treaties made, or which shall be made, under the authority of the United States, shall be the supreme law of the land.... (Article 6, Section 1, Paragraph 2, U.S. Constitution)

### **YHWH's Law**

...hearken ... unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do them, that ye may live.... Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of YHWH your God which I command you.... Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments.... Keep therefore and do them; for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people. For what nation is there so great, who hath God so nigh unto them, as YHWH our God is in all things that we call upon him for? And what nation is there so great, that hath statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day? Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently ... but teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons.... Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong thy days upon the earth, which YHWH thy God giveth thee, for ever. (Deuteronomy 4:1-9, 40)

The law of YHWH is perfect ... the testimony of YHWH is sure.... The statutes of YHWH are right ... the commandment of YHWH is pure ... the judgments of YHWH are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward. (Psalm 19:7-11)

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

## **Does the Constitution promote biblical qualifications for public office, or discourage them?**

### **United States Constitution**

The senators and representatives ... and the members of the several state legislatures, and all executive and judicial officers, both of the United States and of the several states, shall be bound by oath or affirmation, to support this Constitution; but no religious test shall ever be required as a qualification to any office or public trust under the United States. (Article 6, Section 1, Paragraph 3, U.S. Constitution)

### **YHWH's Law**

Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of

truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them, to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens.... (Exodus 18:21)

Thou shalt in any wise set him king over thee, whom YHWH thy God shall choose: one from among thy brethren ... thou mayest not set a stranger over thee, which is not thy brother.... And ... he shall write him a copy of this law in a book.... And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear YHWH his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them: That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: (Deuteronomy 17:15-20)

...Take heed what ye do: for ye judge not for man, but for YHWH, who is with you in the judgment. Wherefore now let the fear of YHWH be upon you.... Thus shall ye do in the fear of YHWH, faithfully, and with a perfect heart. (2 Chronicles 19:5-9)

...rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil.... For he is the minister of God to thee for good. ...he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. (Romans 13:3-4)

## **Does the Constitution promote exclusive worship of Yahweh? ...or does it promote polytheism and idolatry?**

### **United States Constitution**

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof.... (Amendment 1, U.S. Constitution)

### **YHWH's Law**

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If there be found among you ... that hath wrought wickedness in the sight of YHWH thy God, in transgressing his covenant, and hath gone and served other gods, and worshipped them.... Then shalt thou bring forth that man or that woman.... At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death be put to death.... (Deuteronomy 17:2-6)

**Lastly, does the Constitution state, *BY ANY PARTICULARS AT ALL*, which “Creator” or [implied] “God” it is recognizing? No.**

**It can therefore be humanism, Allah, Buddah, or even the god from planet Kolob (Mormonism).**

Think about all this folks. We have work to do. We need to get back to promoting the *Father's* kingdom as we were commissioned. The illuminati needs exposed and this entire deception revealed. Let's roll up our sleeves and get to work, shall we? We weren't called to preach humanist “neutrality” but rather “Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven!”
