

We are in a “covenant” or contract with God, but only if we follow that contract (His Bible):

Do you read and follow the Father’s “book of the law”, or Bible?

Not really, but I pray to Him all the time.

He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination. (*such prayers will be despised by the Father*)

(Proverbs 28:9)

But I don't need to follow the Commandments . me and God have our own arrangement. I know Him like He's my best friend. We get along just fine.

He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

(1 John 2:4)

God's Holy Spirit is in me telling me that I don't have to keep the law anymore!

And we are his witnesses of these things; and *so is* also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

(Acts 5:32)

But I thought the Commandments were done away with on the cross?

For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle (*not even one dot or one dash*) shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

(Matthew 5:18)

My Pastor's a nice guy, he wouldn't lie to me like that.

God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

(Romans 3:4)

That's not fair ! how's anybody supposed to know all this?

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth (*rightly going by the Bible*).

(2 Timothy 2:15)

*Here's something else that's in that "covenant" we have with God,
(should enough of us understand our parts in that contract as a nation)...*

If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
