

## **Is the Mainstream Media becoming one with “*Church* Media”?**

There’s an eerie parallel between the mainstream media and the 501(c)3 church leadership that is so chilling that its just short of outright creepy to the more biblically observant of us. Many around the globe who better understand this see that there is a stranglehold forming around the less committed parts of Christendom like an ever-tightening fowler’s snare. The powers-to-be have infected many arenas, and are forming another generic state-run church, just as they had done in the days of Constantine. But keep in mind, they couldn’t do this without the help of many on the “inside”. Between the good and evil in this game of deception lies the serpent. He is sly, and comes as an angel of light, promising grandeur and glory to those who would ignore even their best inner senses of logic under the guidelines of biblical morals, where they will bite hard on the poisoned lies, and become as a fish on a hook.

Enter two main venues of brainwashing: The mainstream media (the “ministry of propaganda”, as Hitler had called his), and... the mainstream (501(c)3) “church” ministry system. They are so much alike in America anymore that it even looks much like 1930’s Germany now, with both media and church being effectively joined at the hip. Sadly, it is becoming easier and easier to show very clear parallels to expose the underlying agenda, which is an agenda of satan’s design, more so than that of the people themselves of course, as they are less aware of the true purpose that they themselves are playing that makes up the bigger picture.

The Church and the Media have both been slowly partaking of the bread and wine at the alter of the government gods for quite some time now, having been gradually tempted into becoming the now seriously enslaved brainwashing tag-team of the world for the devils bidding. And just as the frog in the kettle scenario that I’m sure most of you know by now, the media and the churches have obediently learned to not “rock the boat” for their new overlords and god: the global elitist state, who under satan, instituted these programs.

So, is this joint effort in “reflecting the will of the government” just another “necessary evil” as many media superstars and fearful preachers claim it is, to keep in step with what we are told to say and do, just because they “say so”? Are we to just close our minds to what is really closing in on us and act like the good little modern-day Catholics that they want us to be? I understand that there may yet come a day where we may be made to make bricks without straw, and in this evil country I would surely feel that such wrath had certainly come with due cause. But to turn myself over in a *spiritual* sense and attend a church that has aligned itself with today’s wicked ruling elite like so many scribes, Pharisees and high priests of the days of old?

Certainly not, and God forbid! In all the parallels that I will show here between the media and the church, there is one very important *non* parallel as well, as that's how the media does not tell or force us by official contract who or how to worship (at least not yet) and we don't have to be a part of any beast-contrived legal documents to chose to listen to such "news" either. But with the churches and their 501(c)3 bonding? ...we are bound to such a beast and its instruction by a contract. Whether we follow it to the tee or rebel a little here and there to make ourselves feel better, we are still under a contract made with the devil, forcing the sovereign lordship of our Savior into the back row. Remember: "sovereign" means "sole". And when speaking of the Messiah being sovereign head of the church, there can therefore be only one head. Under the 501(c)3, at best, two entities share the dual for lordship. Therefore, this is a contract that replaces our Lord and savior as head of the church, with the world's new god... the beast system of the book of Revelation.

But let's look at this comparison between these two influentially broadcasting pulpits a little closer:

The Mainstream media is elusive on certain issues, and the 501(c)3 churches are eerily following an almost identical talking points program. Is it coincidence? ...or can there be a connection that can be causing this somehow? In the war between good and evil there simply has to be a connection to either good or evil, righteousness or corruption, as there is no middle ground, (and this IS... a spiritual war remember).

Some of us are thankfully awake and reassuringly outside the curse of II Thessalonians 2:10-12, while others are tragically being led down the road to slaughter by the "follow the leader" Pastors and Ministers across America that, just like the spineless media heads, also fear repercussions from their true god and overlord: the state. Just as the sell-outs like Glen Beck on the media side, there are untold numbers of various church leaders who are equally too filled with fear or corruption to stand apart from the authority of the gods of this world. And although I feel sorry for them, we can't do anything more for them but continue to beg them to listen, as they must come out of their hiding places as we did and face the truth themselves. They are prisoners of their own fears, which is due to a lack of faith in the true God of the Bible.

But yes, just as the mainstream media, many church leaders have been taking their marching orders from the elite's world-wide beast corporation, whether by clear cooperative intention under willful compliance, knowing full well what they are doing (perhaps for money, prestige or power), or are being sadly coerced by ignorance due again to the lack of their own salvation and faith which, in many cases is self-empowered by their inner fears. A few of the clergy figures that I've spoken to over the last several years have admitted to me candidly that they are afraid, but expect to simply be forgiven for those fears. They fail to rationalize Scripture to find that due to these fears the Father will not accept such an attitude of a vacant faith, whereupon there's nothing more that you or I can do for them. They have perhaps even been lost to the curse of II Thessalonians 2 and the indignation of Titus 3:10, where they are "condemned of themselves". These sad people not only have those passages to answer to when allowing this fear to deceive their own souls, but must face perhaps even harsher penalties in teaching their flocks any of this same fear-based cowardice of compromise, where they will be up against even steeper consequences under the warnings of Matthew 5:19, and Jeremiah 23:1, etc.

Teaching your flock to hide in fear or succumb to replacing the Messiah’s headship over the church with man’s authority under the 501(c)3 obedience system, is tantamount to preaching another god, and is idolatry. Idolatry is a very big problem in the commandments my friends. Its one of the Father’s pet peeves.

But are the ignorant congregations immune from such alliances with this beast system, supposing many of them had not known about these things? Well, if one had truly in his heart genuinely not known such things, I suppose there might be some room for forgiveness there by the Father perhaps, but then we must ask two questions:

But again, back to the media/church parallel topic...

First, let me show the parallels between the churches and the media as they are both addressing their “audiences” in very similar ways:

There are many more comparisons that could be listed in the above chart, but I don’t want to belabor my point and will stop, having listed the more obvious mentions that might get folks in those hypnotized churches thinking.

Consider this: Glenn Beck will touch on many topics where the cat has already been let out of the bag by the alternative media, topics of which may not be too seriously harmful to their secret society overlord’s plans, and then will absolutely turn tail on the ones that he is not “allowed” to talk about. Most preachers strangely follow similar talking point guidelines. Coincidence? Again, we don’t think so. In fact, I feel that these issues are (for the most part) intentionally avoided by church leaders due to instructions not come directly from their government (read: corporate) gods (as the media gets *their* instructions), but delivered *spiritually* via a wide open door to a then vulnerable spirit which is itself due to their greater inner fears of man’s power over them rather than God’s. They fear man’s repercussions over them in a temporal or physical sense, as opposed to God’s power over them in an eternal, spiritual sense.

What about those who have heard that this is a problem and are yet among those pagan-obedient corporations they call churches? Is it willful ignorance? Or willful disobedience?

When one tells you that Glen Beck is “their man”, or that Rush Limbaugh is “the only one they’ll listen to” when it comes to getting their news, what does that tell you? When those of us who know the truth about 9/11 for example, see through the lies of guys like Glen Beck and Sean Hannity, etc, and can see that those media pundits are bought and paid for, we look to other areas for our remaining wisdom, do we not? -at least the smarter of us do anyway, right? Well, what about those who have mountains of so-called or paraded wisdom but are misleading the churches just like Glen Beck and the other media puppets? What about how stupid they try to make the real researchers look? I mean, there have been many people who have told me that they think Alex Jones is a raving lunatic, and just because Glen Beck “said so”. Likewise I have also had uncountable Catholics tell me that their Pope is a great deal smarter than I am, as he wouldn’t be in the position that he’s in if he wasn’t. Well, depending on how one might look at that it could certainly appear to be true, and perhaps Hitler was also “smarter than me” in an academic or secular sense, but what righteousness does that hold up? Not much I’m happy to say. But getting back to the Pope, perhaps he is smarter than me in their eyes, but he specializes in that very form of wit where he knows how to keep the deception going without you knowing about it. In that

respect I'm not "smart enough" no, I admit. Is this wonderfully intelligent Pope on his way to heaven, or any other Pope for that matter? And how about the multi-millions of his "willfully ignorant" followers who really do think that he's smarter than I am? Are they going to heaven with this "really smart guy"? I should not want to be so "smart", thank you.

When one then tells you that there is no problem say, with their church being a 501(c)3 corporation because their "smart" church leader "said so", think of this:

When George W. Bush was asked by an interviewer, "What do you see when you look into the Pope's eyes?" the ex-president, while yet in office simply said, "God". Furthermore, today's new alleged president failed to use a Bible when redoing the oath of office behind closed doors. What does that tell you about where our national leaders dedicate their loyalties? And yet, churches are signing their allegiance to the very same government that these men have stolen out from under us. So who are you signing an allegiance to when you sign into a 501(c)3 government system, or even just knowingly attend such a church? it sure isn't the God of the Bible my friends! You are signed into that "really smart" Pope and his world-wide beast church system, whether you like it or not! You are a part of the very same Babylonian corporation that the Bible warned us about. You are engaging in the worship of the slowly emerging Papal system, or "the beast". One of the last warnings for us in our time in the book of Revelation is this:

*"And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.*

*(Rev 18:4)*

Does it anywhere in that passage say, "come out a little bit"? or "part-way"? No, to come out of a system, you must leave it, lock stock and barrel, if you know the seriousness of the Father's hatred for idolatry (and the "whore of Babylon" that is).

Why is it that so many are led to slaughter by both the media and the false church system anyway and feel so comfortable there? Are they that gullible? Or are they willfully partaking in her sins because safety in numbers has led them to follow the crowd due to fear?

Most in America are victims of their own willful ignorance, and most of that is (again) due to fear. They are overwhelmed and fearful of facing the reality of what is unfolding all around them. This is after having been rocked in the arms of prosperity and over-abundance for so long, that they just simply can't deal with the contrast of what they see coming. The information is out there, but people have found endless reasons or excuses to avoid the true study of the facts. They block it out, and cross their fingers that the God they have kicked out of their churches will forgive them for having signed themselves over to the authority of a new god, their Bohemian Grove-controlled government satanists. The willfully ignorant are viewing their 501(c)3 congregations as safe-havens, perhaps feeling more comfortable all huddled together, hoping to be raptured away just in the nick of time before: the anti-christ, the great tribulation and the persecutions come that they've also been taught to obediently fear.

Where will this lead us? Well, it depends on who "us" really is. If we are solidly standing outside of this beast system, we will be rewarded. If we are too frightened to

stand alone with Christ, we will be sent to the lake of fire with all of the others who are slaves to such fears, just as Revelation 21:8 tells us that this will be the fate of “*the fearful*” (KJV) (or “*the cowardly*” NIV wording, for those afraid of the KJV).

All in all, to be a saint is a matter of faith over fear. It is also a matter of believing the real words delivered to us in the genuine Scriptures, which encourage a true faith of our Messiah, and an obedience to the commandments that will not just make us saints, but *fearless* saints, as the Holy Spirit will empower you to be strong, not wimpy, if you truly understand and embrace the will and love of the Father.

“Thou shalt have no other gods before me”. Do we not fear such a commandment with more respect than say, the rules of a few perverts in Washington? Placing or keeping the 501(c)3 contract over your church is a covenant with that perverted world which then undeniably replaces the authority of the Father’s Bible and His covenant with us. At the end of Revelation 3 in verse 20, where the end times church is represented, there is a very interesting passage for the church. It states: “*Behold I stand at the door and knock...*” why would the Messiah say such a thing unless he had been left out in the cold, outside of the church? He’s calling us to leave those who have signed themselves into a pact with the church system of *this* world, as remember, our Savior said, “*my kingdom is not of this world*” (John 18:36)

If you therefore love your heavenly Father, you will obey His word and “come out from among them and be ye separate, saith the LORD”. It sdoes NOT tell us to obey the One World Church’s alternative command to “go ye in among them and be desperate, saith *their* lord” (as in *their* lord, the lord of *this* world: satan.).
