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My dear friends,

As my efforts have shown in many various illustrations over the years, there's no such thing as a neutral ground between YHWH and the selfish one. We all have to choose sides. We are in a temporal life whereupon that "time" between birth and death was given each of us to be that place where we were each given a temporary neutral "test" window to choose between one world or the other.

In our specific generation, that time to make a final choice is much more pronounced and drawing to a close. The Bible refers to such a place of choice in the end as the "valley of decision" (Joel ch 3 and Zech chs 12 & 14, et al), a valley between two mountains (or kingdoms), leaving us but two choices of Kings and governance systems before the valley itself is swallowed up in eternity to either one side or the other. Our Savior is presently splitting this mount into two clear sides to reveal our clear choices, and (essentially) all who are yet unable to stand on one side or the other in this great valley will be forced to stand on one side or the other as that valley of undecided are increasingly swallowed up in wrath. Joel 14:12 is especially uncomfortable looking for those yet standing with the world, so please think hard for me here, my friends:

We are being called, meaning all the world now, to make our final choice on who we trust in for our behavioral guidance, care, protection, and provisions, which is literally a choice between just two options, the first being YHWH and His original source of guidance, security and power which is never changing and thereby incorruptible by those who would want to abuse such powers ...or the second choice which is His adversary's imitation governance powers devised by man that always allow for the corruptions of men that it yes, might abuse such powers over people.

As I have also said for over twenty years now:

I can picture YHWH standing before all of His creation on judgment day simply saying, "See? I told you that you couldn't govern yourselves without me."

Those who trusted in man's governments and politics will then, on that day, be granted an eternity with the ultimate picture of man's "self" kind of moral direction and governance, as opposed to those who more faithfully trusted in YHWH, trusting in a more responsible governance promised by Him and His Son, where they will be granted a much better eternity with the ultimate picture of YHWH's kind of moral direction. So one group will get an utter utopia of peace, love and beauty, while the other group will get the end product of the illustrious governance that we see over the world now, an eternity of utter despair, pain and anguish.

Are these two choices not clear here, folks? Can we honestly see any wiggle room as if there's some kind of third choice for the folks who fear being committed to one side or the other?

...I don't think so.
